








CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS


Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE


Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.


ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2014-15.




FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

School Goals

Phoenix Charter School provides students an opportunity to find school success and build their pathway to college and careers through a Learn, Serve, and Earn approach. Current goals for the school center on serving youth through a trauma-informed lens as a means to support students with an intentional focus on building personal resiliency. Instruction not only seeks high academic standards through a project-based learning approach, but also a focus on career connected skills to prepare youth for the workforce.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

Phoenix Charter School strives to ensure all students and their families feel welcome to enter our school. Our program design has every student formally linked with at minimum one adult who knows their story and can support them along their journey. Our Student Support Team is skilled in meeting the needs of students who may need additional wraparound supports. We use SafeOregon as an anonymous reporting tool to reduce bullying and harassment and our Hope Squad to support students in need.
